

PASCUAL CABANES

Conductor



Born in Lliria (Valencia), he is one of the most young Spanish conductors of today, conducting as a guest in festivals and orchestras in Spain, Italy, Poland, Portugal, Bulgaria, Egypt, Brazil, etc.

Awarded Best Conductor in the 2020 and 2022 editions of the Caixabank Orchestra Competition of the Valencian Community, Pascual Cabanes holds a higher degree in the specialties of Orchestra Conducting and Horn, a degree in Orchestra and Band Conducting with distinction from the ABRSM of London, and holds a Master's Degree in Musical Research from the International University of Valencia (VIU).

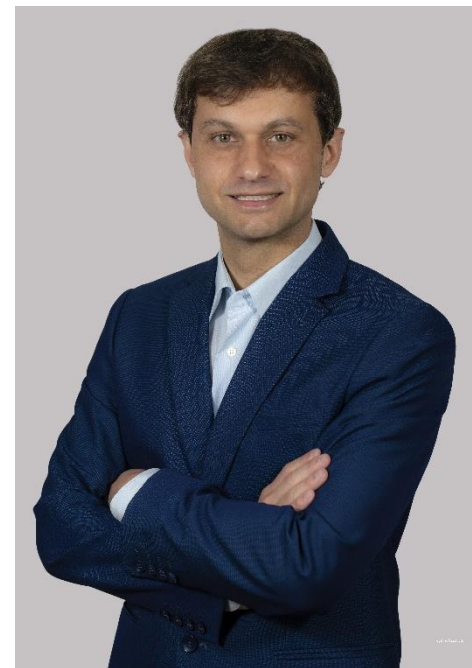
He has conducted in major venues such as the National Music Auditorium in Madrid, the Palau de la Música in Valencia, the Palau de les Arts Reina Sofía, the Cuenca Auditorium, and the Palma Auditorium, as well as in numerous theaters and venues throughout Spain and other European countries, conducting internationally renowned soloists. During the 2018-19 season, he was assistant conductor of the FSMCV Youth Symphony Orchestra and resident conductor of the Cuenca Religious Music Week. Furthermore, from October 2018 to July 2023, he was principal conductor of the Unió Musical de Lliria Symphony Orchestra.

In April 2023 he will make his debut as a guest conductor in the Satellites Cycle of the National Orchestra of Spain with an entire program of Ligeti to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the composer's birth. Among his recent and upcoming international performances as a guest conductor, we can highlight his collaborations with Cairo Symphony Orchestra (Egypt), Claudio Santoro National Theatre Symphony Orchestra of Brasilia (Brazil), Entre Ríos Symphony Orchestra (Argentina), Chile Chamber Orchestra, Lomza Camerata Philharmonic Orchestra (Poland), Kaliska Philharmonic Orchestra (Poland), Kielce Philharmonic Orchestra (Poland), Abruzzese Symphony Orchestra (Italy), Sicilian Symphony Orchestra (Italy), Camerata Strumentale Siciliana (Italy), "Benedetto Marcello" Orchestra (Italy), Matera and Basilicata Orchestra (Italy), Cilea Theatre Orchestra of Reggio Calabria (Italy), Campana Philharmonic Orchestra (Italy), Braga Philharmonic Orchestra (Portugal), Plovdiv State Opera Orchestra. (Bulgaria), Pazardzhik Symphony Orchestra (Bulgaria), Vratsa Symphony Orchestra (Bulgaria), Valencia Orchestra (Spain), Malaga Philharmonic Orchestra (Spain), etc.

A distinguished student of maestro Cristóbal Soler, he has also studied orchestral conducting with Miguel Romea and Andrés Salado, and has taken courses and masterclasses in conducting with professors as John Carewe, Yaron Traub, Arturo Tamayo, José L.Temes or Álvaro Albiach.

He is currently the artistic and musical director of Harmonie Ensemble. He is also the pedagogical director and conducting professor at the "José Collado" International Academy of Orchestral Conducting, and a professor of orchestra and band, and of conducting, at the advanced degree and master's level in orchestral conducting at the High Performance Music School (ESMAR) (Valencia).
